Registration Opens for Annual Charity Golf Tournament at Geothermal Resources Council Annual Meeting

(Salt Lake City, Utah, USA) The Geothermal Resources Council (GRC) has announced more details of events at the world's largest annual geothermal conference, held this year in Salt Lake City, Utah, USA, October 1-4, 2017.

Just before the start of the GRC Annual Meeting & GEA Geo Expo+, the GRC Annual Charity Golf Tournament will take place October 1 at the Mountain Dell Golf Course just 16 miles from the conference site. Registration for the tournament is now open.

This year the proceeds from the tournament will go to the GRC Scholarship Fund.

The Canyon Course, situated 16 miles east of downtown Salt Lake City and at an altitude of 6,000 feet above sea level, offers 18 holes of breathtaking views and frequent glimpses of wildlife. The higher elevation provides ideal summer and early fall golfing conditions. The golf-ball will fly a little bit further!
